Canada's Hand Hygiene Campaign

Train-the-Trainer Sessions on the Observation Tool for Hand Hygiene

CPSI in partnership with the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care is pleased to provide train-the-trainer sessions on a national observational tool and training program for measuring hand hygiene compliance.

This program is designed to teach participants how to use a standardized approach to hand hygiene training and compliance measurement. Use of a national approach to measure compliance rates will provide for comparative data across facilities.

Who should attend?

Infection Prevention and Control Professionals or Educators who have (1) hand hygiene measurement as part of their portfolio and (2) the responsibility to train other healthcare professionals, are encouraged to attend.

1. The participant's organization must be registered in Canada's Hand Hygiene Campaign. To join Canada's Hand Hygiene Campaign please register at www.handhygiene.ca.
2. The participant **must** be in a capacity to train other healthcare professionals within their organization, region and/or province.
3. Space is limited therefore we may need to limit the number of individuals from one organization or region.

Why attend?

By participating in the train-the-trainer sessions, attendees will acquire the skills to:

1. Understand how to use "Your 4 Moments for Hand Hygiene" to teach health care providers the essential indications for hand hygiene
2. Train observers in the correct use of a standard observation tool and audit process
3. Understand the issues related to reliability and rationale for the methods used to analyze compliance data

What will be covered?

The participants will learn the following:

1. Application of "Your 4 Moments for Hand Hygiene"
2. Review of hand hygiene techniques
3. Instructions on how to use the hand hygiene observation tool
4. Practice using the observation tool in simulated clinical scenarios
5. Review of methods for analyzing compliance data
6. Discussion of feedback process
